Polish Masses at St Charles

Bearing in mind the number of different groups who customarily use the church, the size of the church and the present demands regarding public health, **the bishop has decreed that the church of St Charles should temporarily serve only the Polish community.** Fr Leszek, the chaplain, and the Sheffield Polish Catholic Mission, having fulfilled the necessary inspection and review of procedures, are now able to use the church. I shall of course inform you of any future change and I apologise for any disappointment or inconvenience caused.

Changing Sunday Mass times at St Joseph's

From Sunday, 4 October, the Sunday morning Masses at St Joseph's will change to **9.00am** & 10.00am.

Given the circumstances - the oncoming change of the season, the church doors being kept open for the circulation of air, the relative brevity of the Masses, etc – it seemed opportune to make a slight adjustment to the early 8.30am Mass time without disturbing the later 10.00am Mass. It looks like things will remain different for some time yet.

Reading & Altar Serving

Readers – I propose having one reader at Mass using a microphone situated by St Joseph's statue. You may read from your own missal, Magnificat, etc, or a sheet will be provided for you.

Altar Serving – I'm afraid handling the books and sacred vessels is still not permitted but carrying acolytes and ringing the bells (all suitably cleansed between Masses, etc) should be possible. Clearly, cassocks and cottas would have to be taken home and not worn by anyone else.
