The **Feast of Corpus Christi** is celebrated next weekend, 18 & 19 June. The practice of holding a Corpus Christi Procession in the city centre will resume again this year, starting at 3.00pm from St Marie's Cathedral on the Sunday afternoon.

The **Feast of St Peter & St Paul**, a *Holyday of Obligation*, will be celebrated with a vigil Mass at 7.00pm on Tuesday, 28 June, and a 10.00am Mass on the feast day, 29 June.

World Youth Day, Lisbon, August 2023: our diocese is hoping to take 35 young people aged 17 - 30 to WYD next year.
