Please note, at this Sunday's 10.00am Mass:

- There is no *Gloria* sung at a Requiem.
- The readings will be proper to this Mass and not those of the Sunday:
The Book of Wisdom, 3:1, 6. 9., '*He accepted them as a holocaust.*'
The Responsorial Psalm 22 (23), '*The Lord's my Shepherd.*'
The Gospel of St John, 12:23–28 '*If a wheat grain dies, it yields a rich harvest.*'
- We will sing together the responsorial psalm, hymn number, 806.
- After the post-Communion prayer there will be the antiphon, '*In paradisum*' sung and then the prayer of Final Commendation for Queen Elizabeth II. This will be followed by a period of silent prayer.
- We shall conclude with a prayer for King Charles III which will then be followed by the national anthem, '*God save the King*'.

N.B. This Monday, 19 September, the morning Mass will be at 9.00am.

Next Sunday, 25 September, there will be a second collection for Home Mission Sunday. This assists our bishops and their work of evangelisation in England and Wales. Your support is greatly appreciated.
