The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick

The feast of Our Lady of Lourdes on Tuesday, 11 February, is also the occasion of the annual World Day of Prayer for the Sick. This is an observation that was introduced by Pope St John Paul II as a way for believers to offer their prayers for those suffering from illnesses. As we established a couple of years ago, this means that I will offer the **Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick at the conclusion of the 5.00pm Mass next Saturday**, 8 February, and at the end of the Sunday morning Masses, 9 February.
