On **Sunday**, **2 February**, the Church celebrates the feast of the **Presentation of the Lord** which occurs forty days after the birth of Jesus. It is also known as *Candlemas Day*, since the blessing of candles forms a part of the day's liturgy. If you use candles at home as part of your personal prayer or for a shrine, etc., then you are most welcome to bring them along to the Saturday vigil Mass or on the Sunday morning for them to be blessed. **N.B.** As a feast of the Lord, the readings and prayers are proper to the feast and are not those of the Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time.

The feast of Our Lady of Lourdes on **Tuesday, 11 February**, is also the occasion of the annual **World Day of Prayer for the Sick**. This is an observation that was introduced by Pope St John Paul II as a way for believers to offer their prayers for those suffering from illnesses. As we established a couple of years ago, this means that I will **offer the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick** at the conclusion of the **5.00pm** Mass on **Saturday, 8 February**, and also at the end of the **Sunday morning Masses, 9 February**.
