Outside of this annual request the only other income the cemetery receives is from the occasional sale of a grave plot and the administration concerning headstones, etc. The majority of these costs therefore are borne by the parishioners of St Joseph's through their Sunday collection (approximately £3000 to £5000 a year depending on the work).
